I. General instructions

1. About these use and care instructions

The present b Solitaire use and care instructions seat shell inform you about the intended use and care of your b Solitaire seat shell. The safety instructions which are included in the use and care instructions are important to prevent personal injury and damage to property as a consequence of abnormal use of the b Solitaire seat shell. Users of the b Solitaire seat shell are therefore obliged to take note of these safety instructions and to observe them at all times.

The b Solitaire use and care instructions seat shell are part of the b Solitaire seat shell and are only valid as a complete document. If the seat shell is passed on, the use and care instructions are part of the scope of delivery, and must therefore be kept safely.

2. About the b Solitaire seat shell

The b Solitaire seat shell serves as a bench cushion with backrest for b Solitaire benches to achieve the comfortable seating of a chair with backrest. Before the first, and any further use, the b Solitaire seat shell must be fixed to the b Solitaire bench with the help of the provided safety brackets in accordance with the enclosed b Solitaire safety brackets instructions for assembly (see also Section II. 1.).

Dimensions of the b Solitaire seat shell:

- Seat width: 60 cm
- Seat depth: 36 cm
- Height of backrest: 38 cm

The b Solitaire seat shell has been tested, is monitored, and its production and distribution are subject to quality control. The seat shell fulfills the requirements of the EU General Product Safety Directive.

3. IMPORTANT INFORMATION on the consequences of noncompliance with these use and care instructions



Always observe the b Solitaire use and care instructions seat shell when using the b Solitaire seat shell. We expressly point out that any noncompliance with these use and care instructions regarding the use of the b Solitaire seat shell can lead to personal injury and damage to property.

II. Basic safety instructions

1. Intended use

Assembly and use of the b Solitaire seat shell

Always fix the b Solitaire seat shell to your b Solitaire bench with the help of the provided safety brackets in accordance with the enclosed b Solitaire safety brackets instructions for assembly. The safety brackets covers the seating area of the bench and in doing so prevents the seat shell from slipping and tipping backwards.

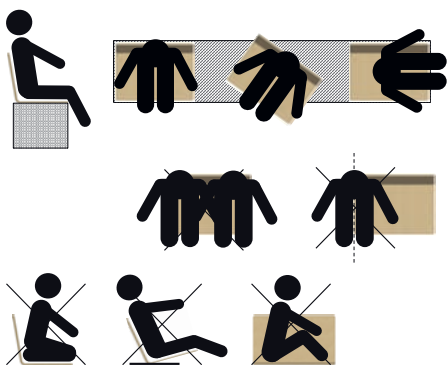
Ensure that the seat shell is not positioned over the front edge of the bench underneath. This is classed as an incorrect or abnormal use which can cause the seat shell to tip forwards. Any wrong positioning such as this is immediately noticeable and must be corrected accordingly by the user without delay.

Maximum load capacity

The b Solitaire seat shell is approved for use by one (1) person with a **maximum body weight of 125 kg**.

Admissible and non-admissible sitting positions

The b Solitaire seat shell may only be used by a person sitting upright. The user's legs protrude over the front edge of the seat shell.



Indoor use

Due to the high-quality leather (see Section IV. 1. for details), the b Solitaire seat shell is only designed for **indoor use**. This means that you should use the b Solitaire seat shell in enclosed indoor areas only. It is not designed for use in outdoor areas (in the open).

2. Abnormal use



Abnormal use of the b Solitaire seat shell can lead to danger to life and limb as well as property damage. This is why any abnormal use is prohibited.

Possible abnormal use of the seat shell:

- Using the seat shell on a different bench than the b Solitaire bench
- Using the seat shell without safety brackets
- Exposing the seat shell to loads which exceed the load capacity specified by bulthaup (Section II. 1.)
- Use of the seat shell by more than one (1) person or several persons
- Using the seat shell outdoors
- Improper maintenance and care of the seat shell
- Selling/passing on the seat shell to third parties without passing on the use and care instructions as well

General use in private and public indoor areas

The b Solitaire seat shell can be used in private indoor areas, as well as in public indoor areas, i.e. it can be used in non-living areas for "general use".

"General use" includes areas in which seating furniture is usually designed for various types of use (general use: short-time high load and light load for several hours). Examples: all types of office buildings, exhibition rooms, public halls, event locations, cafés, restaurants, canteens, banks, bars. Areas in which seating furniture is exposed to extreme loads at times or repeatedly due to the specific type of use or due to unintended use are to be differentiated. This means that "general use" does not include e.g. use in night clubs, police stations, traffic centers, changing rooms in gyms, prisons, or military barracks (unguarded areas).

Any different application or use which goes beyond the intended use of the seat shell, which is described above (i.e. use in private or public outdoor areas), shall be considered abnormal use and is therefore not allowed.

III. Additional safety instructions

Users with disabilities

The b Solitaire seat shell can be used by children over the age of eight and persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental abilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they are supervised or have been instructed regarding the safe use of the b Solitaire seat shell and understand the resulting hazards.



Never leave children unsupervised while they are using the b Solitaire seat shell.

Keep all packaging parts out of the reach of children. The packaging must be disposed of in accordance with local regulations. Improper disposal and recycling of the product or the packaging will lead to the exclusion of any liability of Bulthaup.

IV. Care instructions

Thoroughly read the care instructions before cleaning to avoid any damage to your b Solitaire seat shell.

1. General instructions

The leather which is used for the b Solitaire seat shell is vegetable-tanned and aniline-dyed. After a short period of use, leather will develop a patina. This creates the typical characteristics of this natural material. Avoid direct exposure to sunlight. Sunlight and artificial light can lighten the color and dry out the leather. Too much heat is bad for the leather. The seat shell should have a clearance of at least 30 cm to radiators. If exposure to heat cannot be avoided, the leather requires more frequent care.



Wipe any dirt and spilled liquids off immediately so that no stains or discolorations develop which are usually difficult or even impossible to remove.

Do not use:

- Cleaning agents containing abrasive particles
- Bleach, highly acidic, or alkaline cleaning agents
- Substances containing solvents (e.g. nitro diluents)
- Cleaning agents containing chlorine, iodine or bromine
- Steam-cleaning equipment
- Wire wool or cleaning sponges with a rough side
- Pointed objects

Test cleaning and care products in an inconspicuous area before use.

2. Cleaning

Wipe off the leather gently using a soft cotton cloth. Avoid vigorous rubbing, as it can cause unsightly shiny patches. Moisture should be wiped off immediately with an absorbent cloth. Only clean the leather with a damp cloth; it should never be too wet. Use distilled water for cleaning to avoid lime stains. Cleaning should be performed covering a large area, from seam to seam.

3. Care

To prevent stains and discoloration, you should regularly care for the leather with a low-viscosity emulsion suitable for vegetable-tanned and aniline-dyed leather. Observe the manufacturer's instructions on the care product. Even impregnation will not make the leather insensitive against potential damage. The best way to protect and maintain the leather will be continuous careful handling.
